Dear Mr President!

On behalf of the Humanistic Outlook Group (HOG), as a leader of the organization I lead, I am honoured to share with You my thoughts on the forthcoming re-election of Mr Tedros Adhanom as Director-General of the World Health Organisation in May 2022.

According to predictions by the HOG, if representatives of WHO member states re-elect Mr Tedros as head of the organization, this decision would further strengthen the dictatorship of the WHO and consequently undermine the sovereignty, security and economic stability of a number of nations around the world.

The basis for this prediction is that the WHO and its Director-General have already acquired very broad rights and powers in recent years and, despite this, they seek to broaden such powers further.

Meanwhile, it is clear that the World Health Organisation and its leadership have failed to prevent the outbreak of COVID-19 and end the pandemic because their recommendations, statements and other actions have contributed to a pandemic of fear and panic (a worldwide psychological crisis) which in turn has led to reduced human immunity, increased morbidity and mortality, unprecedented large-scale human rights violations and, all in all, to the crisis of the operation of the WHO as an organization as well as to a crisis of the UN, EU, CoE and other international organizations.

As evidence of the current WHO Director-General's quest for unlimited power, and to illustrate the helplessness of the organization he leads in tackling the new coronavirus infection, please allow me to simply present two quotes:

Two years before the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak, on February 12, 2018 at the World Government Summit "Can we create a pandemic-free world?" held in Dubai, the WHO Director-General made the following statement: "I would also like WHO to play a political role, not just a technical role." In the midst of the pandemic, on August 11, 2021, the chief executive of the WHO acknowledged that "we have a number of effective vaccines and yet the numbers of cases and deaths are still on the rise".

In view of the above, the Humanistic Outlook Group calls on the leaders of all WHO Member States to once again carefully consider the implications of Mr Tedros's reappointment as WHO chief executive for the period of 2022-2027 and to instruct their representatives to the World Health Assembly to ensure that the current Director-General is not re-elected for a second term.

We are convinced that Your decision will have a great impact on the preservation and strengthening of the sovereignty, security and economic stability of many nations of the world and thus on the fate of the world and whether humanity is awaited by dictatorship or the triumph of freedom and humanism.
